Early Years Educators play a crucial role in supporting young children's learning and development, while ensuring their health, safety, and well-being are prioritised.

This apprenticeship provides the skills and professional behaviours needed to work effectively across a variety of early years settings, including day care, children's centres, and preschools.

EPA / APPRENTICESHIP ASSESSMENT:

1. Observation with questions

Apprentices will also work towards Functional Skills Level 2 in Maths and English, if not already exempt.

This apprenticeship is suitable for anyone in a junior early years practitioner role.

Apprentices will develop key skills and behaviours to support their progression towards level 3 early years educator. The role will involve planning and supervising child initiated and adult led activities, supporting children to develop numeracy and language skills, observing each child and shape their learning experience to reflect their observations and much more.

The Early Years Educator Apprenticeship may be a gateway to further career opportunities, such as early years educator and childminder.
