Lead Practitioners in Early Years settings are proactive and influential professionals who work directly with children, taking responsibility for leading day-to-day practice at an operational level.

They are typically responsible for guiding and supporting other practitioners, ensuring high-quality provision and contributing to the overall development and delivery of early years education and care.
